MESSAGE FROM THE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR




Stonnington Jazz is now in its sixth year of presenting some of the finest talent on the Australian jazz scene. The festival's success to date is a credit to the vision of the Councillors and key staff of the City of Stonnington.

One of the challenges involved in programming an event like this is striking a balance between presenting familiar names – artists that we know can deliver at a high standard, and whom we know the audience will want to see – and including new names

(often younger performers) who can benefit from the opportunity to be introduced to new audiences.

Established favourites like Vince Jones, Joe Chindamo, Allan Browne and Paul Williamson will present special programs again this year. Sarah McKenzie was a new name to many who saw her at Stonnington Jazz 2010; she made such a strong impression then, we decided to have her open this year's program at Malvern Town Hall.



Reinforcing our association with the Wangaratta Jazz festival, Stonnington Jazz will feature trumpeter Eamon McNelis, winner of the 2010 National Jazz Awards at Wangaratta, with his band Bopstretch. We will also present Sydney pianist Stu Hunter, whose concerts at Wangaratta last year were acclaimed as one of the hits of the festival; and Andrew Robson's Tallis Quartet, one of the standout bands at Wangaratta in 2009.

Other highlights will include a concert from the Jazzgroove Mothership Orchestra from Sydney, joined by guest vocalist Kristin Berardi; saxophonist Jamie Oehlers visiting from Perth for a duo concert with Paul Grabowsky; a rare Melbourne appearance by Dave MacRae and Joy Yates with their daughter, Jade MacRae; and performances from respected artists like Scott Tinkler, Ian Chaplin, Tina Harrod, Andy Sugg, James Greening and Shannon Barnett. Bands in the 'new faces' category include the Nat Bartsch Trio and The New Sheiks. And of course, Stonnington's commitment to jazz education will be celebrated in the annual Youth Jazz Workshops and concert, co-ordinated by Bob Sedergreen.

For committed jazz fans, and for music lovers curious to find out more of what jazz has to offer, there will be plenty to enjoy in this year's Stonnington Jazz program.
